Dear Mr. Poenaru:

In 2004 The IIA's Board of Regents approved a tiered pricing structure for the Certified Internal Auditor® (CIA®) exam based on the gross national income (GNI) rankings established and published by the World Bank through its *World Bank Economic, Financial, and Socio-demographic Statistical Indicators*.

In the most recently published World Bank Indicators, Romania moved to a higher income status and therefore to a higher pricing tier for our exam programs. Based on this, we regret that The IIA is not able to offer Romanian candidates reduced exam and application fees for the computer based exams conducted through 2008-2009. Attached is the exam fee structure for all Romanian candidates who take the exam, beginning with the May 2008 launch of CBT.

Please note that the pricing is based on the candidate's country of primary address, not the country where they will sit for the exam.
